How to get the article?

There are three routes to find a full text version of research articles which are not accessible via campus licence or outside the campus network. Please contact your library if you need any help using these routes or if you have any further questions.

- 1) Request article via your library
- → This is often a fast and cheaper option than buying it from the publisher directly. Ask your library for advice.
- 2) Request article via author or research community
- → Ask the author to send you the article (e.g. via ResearchGate). This may not be the fastest, but traditionally a well-used route to access publications.
- → Use the hashtag <u>#icanhazpdf</u> together with the link to the publication you wish to receive. If somebody has access to the document, they can send it to you.
- 3) Search for free full text versions of an article
- → Use browser plug-ins (such as Unpaywall), Open Access Button, Google Scholar, or CORE Discovery, all of which allow users to find articles in non-commercial search engines and institutional repositories.
